The Process:



- 1. First you will draw a number assigning you to a specific team. Then your team will receive a folder explaining the various assigned jobs and roles to choose.
- Once you've picked a role to play in the exploration team, all team members will define the meaning of their assigned roles and define vocabulary words from the dictionary, posting it on the class blog (http://mrsseymour.wordpress.com/)
- 3. (Explorer- Geographer- Meteorologist- Zoologist)
- 4. Use the hyperlinks on the team task page and the list of Resources to help you locate information about your topic.
- 5. Review and complete all the tasks that are assigned to your team on the web quest using all assigned resources and the power point website provided.
- When you have completed your part of the project, you will present your findings to the other team members, then as a team make an art project (poster, diorama, clay art) and to organize your information for the team presentation.
- 7. Together you will design a 10 question quiz on your topic for the other investigating teams to review and answer (short answer-true/false-multiple choice)
- 8. Finally you and your team (all members must be present) will present your report in a power point presentation (www.zohowriter.com) explaining all your findings.

 (short answer-true/false-multiple choice).














